#### **Helpdesk**

This is an online platform with a contact form where EIB Group clients can submit operational questions on green eligibility and reporting topics to technical experts on stand-by. It also features a comprehensive library of FAQs and guidance notes.



#### **EIB Group Green Checker**

This online tool enables users to estimate climate impact and confirm the eligibility of projects under EIB Group green requirements, generate green reporting data and download a PDF report with assessment results. The Green Checker also has API functionalities to be explored.



#### **E-learning**

This self-paced online learning programme with completion certification helps users gain a practical understanding of green investment segments, green eligibility requirements, and to deepen their understanding of green and wider sustainability finance principles.



#### **Webinars**

This series of theme-based training sessions helps users identify green investment opportunities and assess their eligibility and learn from green project case studies and live demos. Topics include the EU taxonomy, the EIB green finance approach, the EIB Group Green Checker, sectoral deep-dives, and more.
